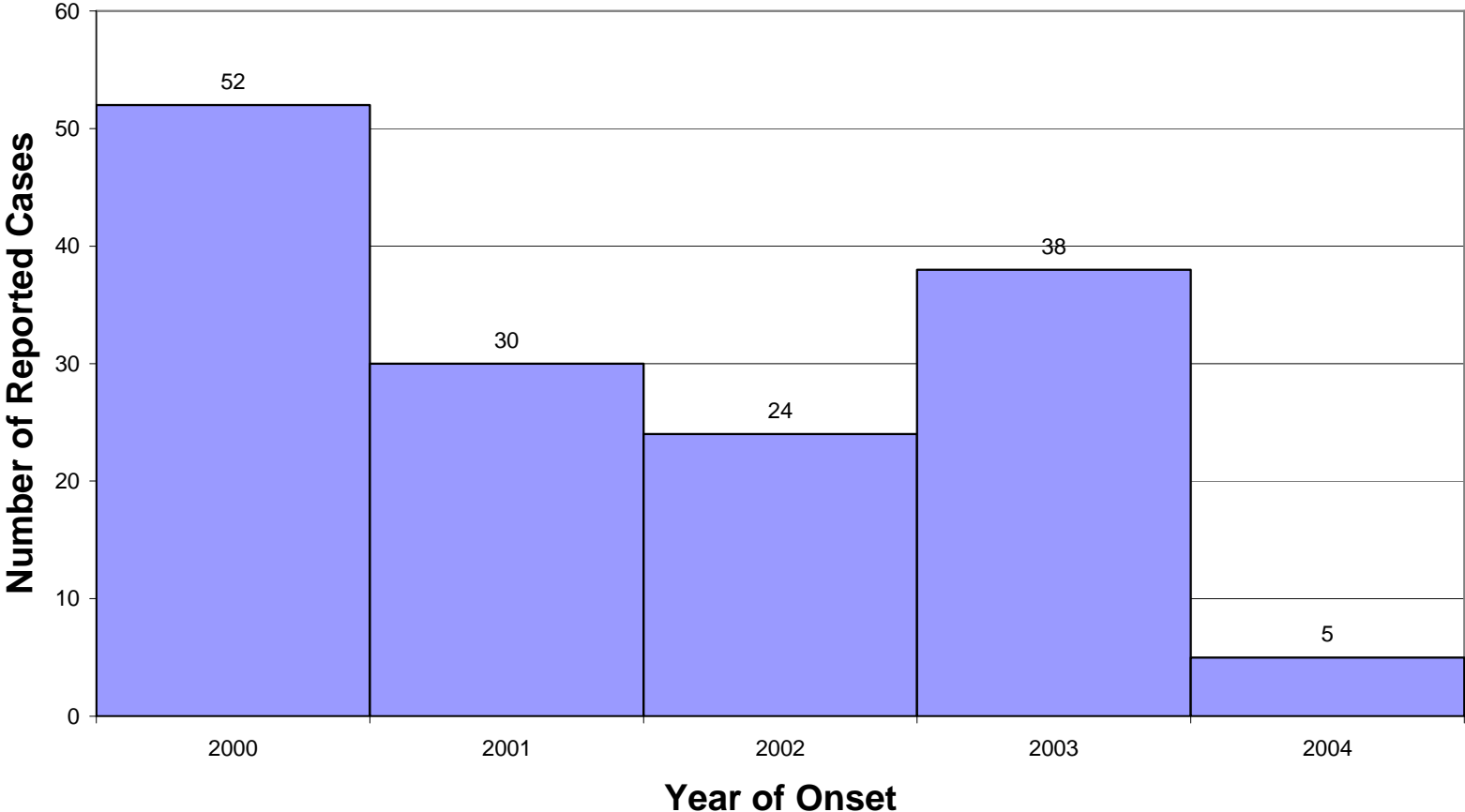
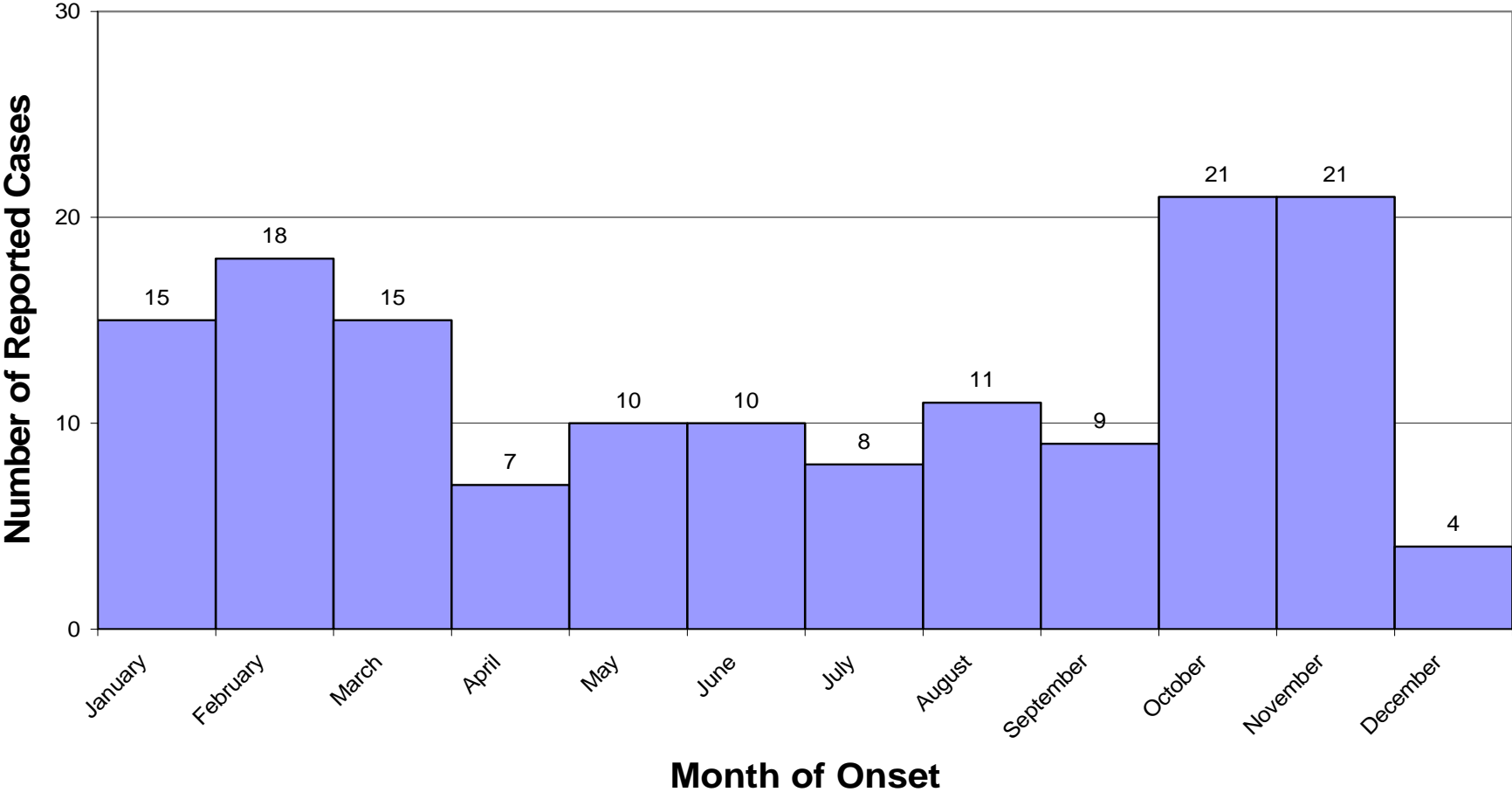


### Cases of Hepatitis A by Year of Onset, West Virginia, 2000-2004; N=149



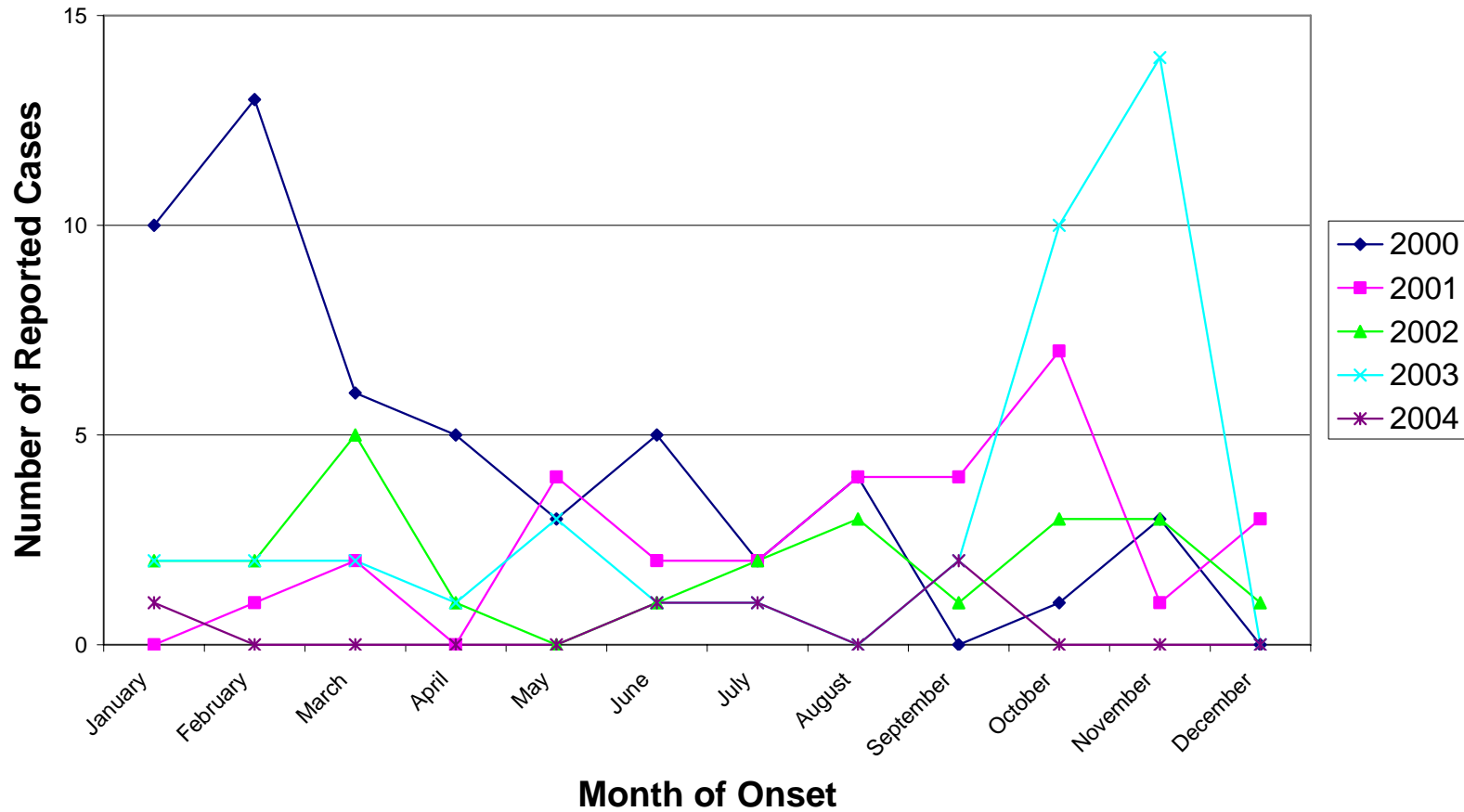
Historical surveillance data in WV illustrates a downward trend in the numbers of Hepatitis A cases. The large number of cases in 2003 is due to a multi-state outbreak related to Chi Chi’s Restaurants.

### Cases of Hepatitis A by Month of Onset, West Virginia, 2000-2004; N=149



The increased number of cases in October and November are due to an outbreak of Hepatitis A that occurred in 2003.

### Cases of Hepatitis A by Year and Month of Onset, West Virginia, 2000-2004; N=149



The large spike in October and November of 2003 is due to a Hepatitis A outbreak that occurred involving green onions from Chi Chi's Restaurants.
