Videos

Considering Your Options – An educational video about contraceptive choices for teenagers. This fast-paced video combined animated segments where “Alex” goes on line to learn more about his contraceptive options, with real teens discussing their choices and concerns about sexual activity and various birth control methods.

Avoiding Teen Pregnancy Series – This is a 3 part video series. The titles are: 1) Taking Care of Business: Contraception for Teens, 2) What Do You Say? Talking About Protection, and 3) Teen Pregnancies? The Role of the Older Guy. Worksheets, role plays and an evaluation tool are included with each video. Running time for each is approximately 30 minutes.

s.t.a.t.s. Sex, Teens, AIDS: Take ‘Em Serious – This video for young males and females ages 12-17. It is designed to stimulate dialogue around responsible sexual behavior and other sexuality issues. The video, edgy, fast-paced and music-oriented, jumps right into the middle of urban life, giving youth information they can use. A discussion guide and users guide is included. Running time: 20 minutes.

Looking for Love, Exploring Teen-Adult Relationships – This program examines the very serious issues of adolescents who are involved in “dating” relationships with persons who are significantly older (adults). In general, teen perceive these relationships as having many benefits. However, the negative consequences of such relationships can be far more reaching, and may include depression, poor school performance, sexually transmitted infections, unintended pregnancy and sexual assault. Multiple activities and copy ready handouts are included. Running time: 22 minutes

Teen Contraception – This video features a male and female teen giving an overview of contraceptive choices. The advantages and disadvantages of each method are reviewed and statistical information regarding success rates is given. Running time: 13 minutes.

Mothers Too Soon – This video explores the lives of teen mothers and offers an excellent starting point for discussion about teen pregnancy and its consequences. Teaching and discussion guide is included. Running time: 20 minutes.

Fathers Too Soon – This video explores the lives of teen fathers and offers an excellent starting point for discussion about teen pregnancy and its consequences. Teaching and discussion guide is included. Running time: 20 minutes.

Jessica’s Story – This video is a compilation of scenes from a major story line on “One Life To Live,” one of ABC’s most popular daytime dramas. The show examined the many ways that teen pregnancy affected the life of Jessica Buchanan (a character on the show who became pregnant at age 18), her parents, her boyfriend, and others in her life. Discussion guide is included. Running time: 10 minutes.


















A Walk in Your Shoes – This video is a special episode of the documentary series, “A Walk in Your Shoes” on the NOGGIN network (owned by Nickelodeon) in which two teen couples switch lives for a day and learn about teen parenting. Discussion and Teaching guide is included. Running Time: 25 minutes.

It's Your Choice: Birth Control for Teens – This video is fast moving and succinct, and is intended to give thorough information about contraceptive methods. Information is presented by peer educations and is interspersed with interviews of real teens giving their opinions of these methods and sharing their experiences. Discussion guide is included. Running time: 30 minutes.








Get More – A series of curricula intended to be conducted primarily with grades 7-12. One goal of the project is to provide education about paternity, child support, adolescent pregnancy prevention, and other realities of teen parenting in an attempt to help frame young people's attitudes about child-rearing. This curriculum has been aligned with the West Virginia Health Education Content Standards and Objectives. Running time: 18 minutes
