EFFECTIVE: June 30, 2022

The West Virginia Breast and Cervical Cancer Screening Program (WVBCCSP) has updated the payment rates for cytology services. These rates are the current Medicare rates. The program will pay up to the amount listed below and any amount up to the listed amount may be charged.
