The Farm Security and Rural Investment Act of 2002 (Public Law 107-171) restores food stamp eligibility to a legal immigrant who has lived in the United States as a qualified alien for a period of five years or longer without meeting the 40 quarter qualification. This policy is effective on April 1, 2003.

Applications to restore food stamps to these immigrants can be taken beginning March 1, 2003 and processed no later than March 31, 2003 so that eligible households receive a full month's benefit beginning on April 1, 2003. All food stamp eligibility requirements are to be met. Applications for households in which some of the members are eligible prior to that time must have applications processed according to regular processing time frames. Counties may then simply add the members who become eligible on April 1, 2003.

This change also adds victims of severe form of trafficking who have been certified by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services making them eligible for benefits and services in Food Stamps, WV WORKS, and Medicaid to the same extent as refugees, as long as all eligibility criteria has been met.
