The purpose of this manual change is to clarify and correct the information released in Change #315 regarding the changes in the 6

month continuation of Support Services. The information on page 2 of the DW-17 in Change #315 regarding Section 24.16 was incorrect.

Section 24.16 - The eligibility requirements for the 6 consecutive months of continued support service payments has not changed. Change #315 was intended to read that effective March 1, 2004, previous or current receipt of this continued support services period would be disregarded allowing clients who meet the general rules under 24.16, B. and the eligibility requirements in 24.16, C. to be eligible for one additional 6 month continuation of support services period. In other words, we are wiping the slate clean. This does not mean that you add or "piggyback" an additional 6 month period to those currently in this 6 month period as of March 1, 2004. That period of eligibility will expire as scheduled. Four new examples to clarify this change have been added on page 68.
