FEDERAL DATA HUB AND DATA EXCHANGES

B. DIVISION OF CHILDREN AND ADULT SERVICES

Information from the Family and Children's Tracking System (FACTS) is provided monthly.

Provider Income

Provider Income information is available the 1st working day after the 2nd Friday of each month. Information received includes adoption, foster care, day care, and demand payments for the previous month.

This information is considered verified upon receipt for SNAP and is not subject to independent verification for all programs.

2. Client Detail

The adult and child information is available around the 10th calendar day of each month. Information received includes client income, asset, placement, demographic, and address details.

This information is considered verified upon receipt for SNAP and is not subject to independent verification for all programs.

C. BUREAU FOR CHILD SUPPORT ENFORCEMENT (BCSE)

New Hire information is available each Monday. Information received includes names and addresses of employers, along with start and end dates of employment.

BCSE collects the New Hire information from employers. All employers do not report consistently when they do provide the information.

This information is not considered verified upon receipt but is considered information from a Third Party Source for SNAP and is subject to independent verification for all programs.
