

12.13 RE-EVALUATION OF DISABILITY, INCAPACITY OR BLINDNESS

At the time of the initial approval of blindness, incapacity or disability, MRT determines whether or not the client's circumstances require a re-evaluation of his medical condition. If a re-evaluation is required, the Worker is responsible for providing the medical or social information needed by MRT. The MRT re-evaluation decision is noted on the ES-RT-3 and/or the DFA-RT-3M or ES-RT-13.

The most recent MRT determination that the individual is blind, incapacitated, or disabled is considered as established and continues until MRT determines otherwise, and issues a decision.
