17.33 CASE MAINTENANCE

A. COUNTY TRANSFER

When an I/DD client moves from one county to another, the case record must be transferred to the new county of residence. See Section 17.3.

B. CHANGES IN INCOME

NOTE: Income is not deemed for I/DD cases. When the client's income increases to above 300% of the SSI payment level, he is no longer eligible for I/DD services. The Worker must:

- Notify the LTC/AC Unit of the ending date of eligibility for I/DD.
- Notify the client or his representative by providing 13 days notice.
- Notify the case management agency.
- Take appropriate data system action.
- Evaluate the client for all other Medicaid coverage groups.

C. CLOSURE/DENIAL

When an I/DD case is closed or denied and an application is taken for nursing care services, no waiver services are covered under Medicaid.
