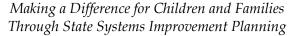

Theory of Action

The WV Birth to Three Theory of Action is a component of the State System Improvement Plan (SSIP), and the State Performance Plan (SPP). The Theory of Action is a visual description of the major activities the State will take to support change at the local level to achieve the State Identified Measurable Result (SIMR). The SIMR for WVBTT is to increase the numbers of infants and toddlers exiting WVBTT who have made enough progress in their social emotional skills to move closer to their same age peers. The activities identified in the Theory of Action are matched to the results of the data analysis, in a way that is most likely to help achieve the SIMR.

Five Core Areas of the Theory of Action

Data Modernization The WVBTT statewide data system will be enhanced to include entry of Child Outcomes measurement ratings and the assignment of a unique child identifier. The modernization is designed to increase the monitoring and completeness of Child Outcomes data.

Communication

WVBTT will implement a comprehensive communication plan to routinely share detailed Child Outcomes data and SSIP activities with stakeholders. The communication plan is intended to gather input from professionals and community partners and help them be informed and invested in improvement strategies.

Interagency Collaboration

WVBTT will collaborate with early childhood partners to implement a public awareness campaign to increase the awareness of the importance of and ways to support social emotional development.
