**Cindy Chamberlin** is a physical therapist with over 29 years of experience working with children. She has worked in the West Virginia Birth to Three program for more than 19 years and Clay County schools for more than 11 years. Prior to that she implemented the developmental care program in Raleigh General Hospital's NICU. She has been working with substance exposed and neonatal abstinence syndrome (NAS) babies since her NICU days and has seen the steady increase in numbers as well as observed these children as they transition into school and the impacts that it has had on our educational system. She is the WV Chapter President of To The Moon and Back, a nonprofit dedicated to providing support for the families and professionals working with these children.
