

FIRST STEPS TO GOING GREEN! Make the best informed decision!

How do I store additional electronic files on my PC/smartphone/tablet/iPad? What can I find that is free? What software will best fit my budget for e-signatures?

I am sure that your thoughts have been flying and the list continues to grow with questions with what seems like no end in sight! From PC-MAC-Android-iPhone-tablet or notebook, the list of various types of devices can be overwhelming at first.

The good news is - **YOU MAY NOT NEED TO BUY NEW EQUIPMENT!!** What you have may be just what you need with some additional tools that are either free or can be purchased. Let's look at steps that you should consider taking now.

OPERATING SYSTEM



Before you can begin to consider additional tools for your PC-MAC-Android-iPhone-tablet or notebook, you must first know what type of *operating sys*tem that you have. This is important because if you have an older PC or MAC, many of the newer programs will not run successfully on your computer. Also, the software that you have invested in, may not be compatible with your device. On most devices, go to your SETTINGS and select ABOUT from the menu list. That will provide you with the specifications of your device. You will be able to review your version, amount of RAM, Product ID, System type, etc. Information that is necessary to make an informed decision for new tools or software.

ENCRYPTION REQUIREMENTS



As a BTT practitioner, interim or on-going service coordinator, you are required to encrypt any emails that contain a child or family's personally identifiable information.

Check your email service FIRST to see if you have built-in encryption capability. You may just need to turn it on or "add" it to your device. When you use an e-signature program, your information is automatically encrypted.

STORAGE

Flash Drives - a cost affordable option is using encrypted flash drives. You do not need an internet connection to store documents on a flash drive. A flash drive provides a good option for storing your documents when you are in areas with poor internet or no internet service. When you return from your visit, you can transfer information from the flash drive to a more secure location such as your PC.

While they offer a level of protection for storage, due to their size, they are not recommended for long-term storage as they can be easily lost or misplaced.

Cloud Storage - once again...review your computer/smartphone/tablet to see what type of long -term storage is a part of your system. From add-ons to additional programs, there are several available. Here a some options:
