

## Public Notice

The public is hereby notified that the Department of Health and Human Resources, Office of Maternal, Child and Family Health (OMCFH), and WV Birth to Three is posting the State's application for FFY2012 funds under Part C of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act, for public comment. This application includes some changes proposed in response to new Part C, IDEA regulations, including changes in transition requirements and late referrals to Part C. The grant application is required by the U.S. Department of Education, Office of Special Education Programs as a condition of funding. The application is available for review at any WV Birth to Three Regional Administrative Unit (RAU), the WV Developmental Disabilities Council, the West Virginia Secretary of State's Office, or online at [www.wvdhhr.org/birth23](http://www.wvdhhr.org/birth23) from February 11, 2012 through April 11, 2012.
