Hello everyone,

I want to let you know that the WVBTT COVID-19 training sessions have changed a bit regarding providing services in childcare. Please know that we are now instructing everyone that service professionals must talk with each childcare setting and find out if they are accepting any other service providers into their childcare setting. Childcare centers are at various stages and everyone must check in to see what is happening with each center. So, if a WVBTT practitioner had an authorization to provide services in childcare prior to COVID-19, they could have that same authorization after July 1, assuming that the family has given permission.

Of course we also want you to remember that we have a TA Bulletin from last August that reflects the importance of a coordinated approach to identify the need to support childcare providers. Please be sure your teams are always following that TA Bulletin. The TA Bulletin says that there must always be some type of service for a family, even when services are provided to support childcare.
