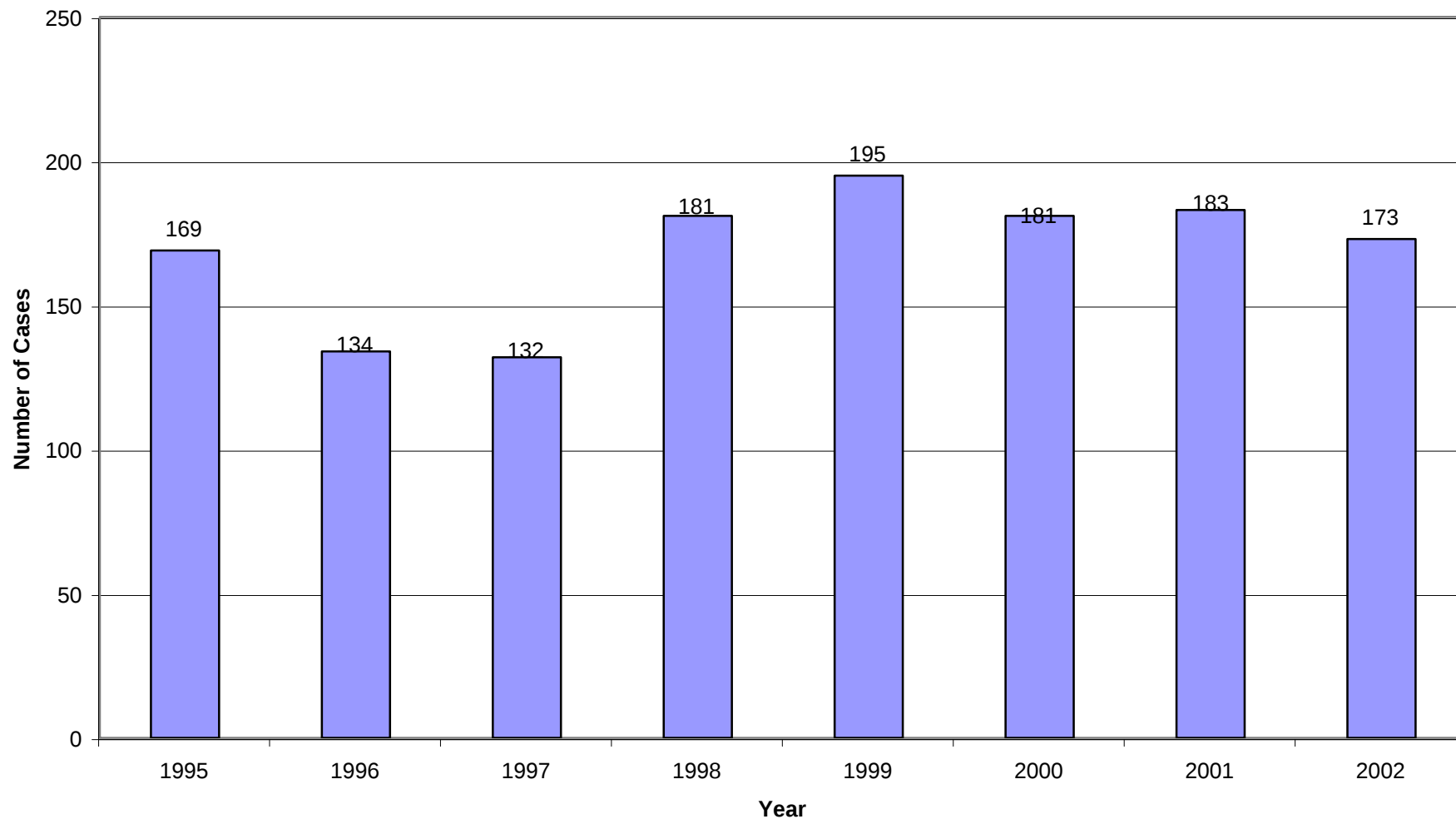
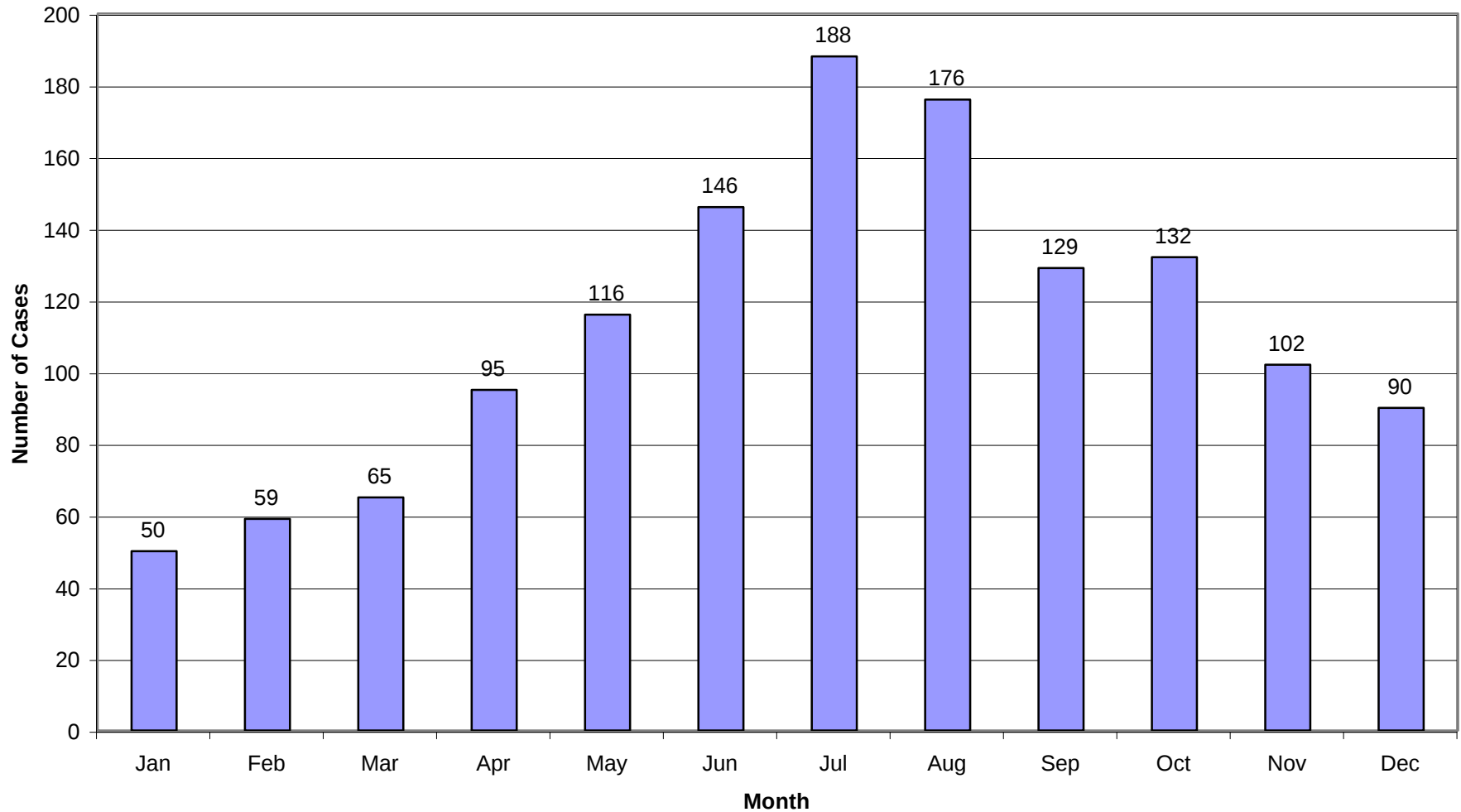


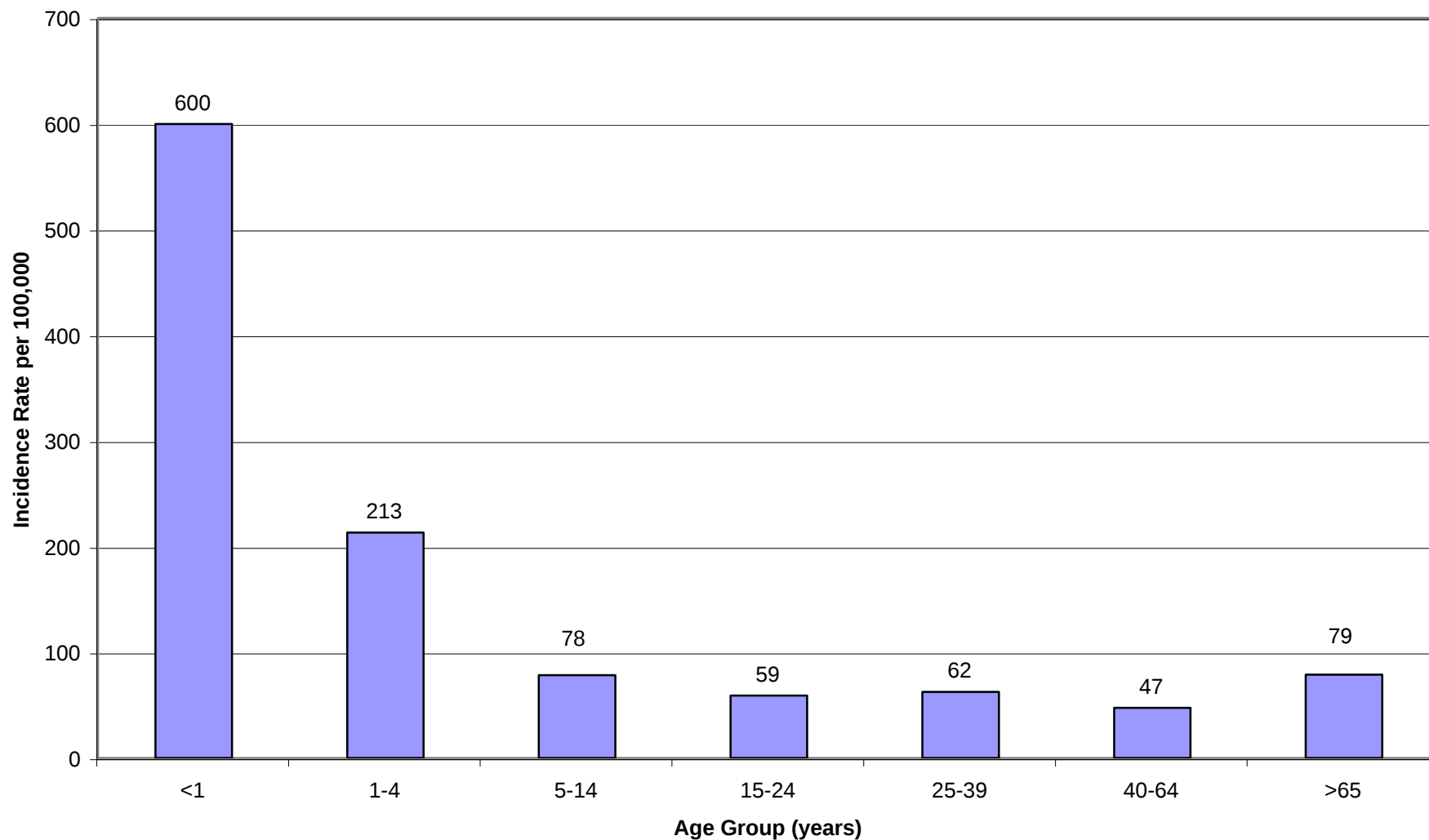

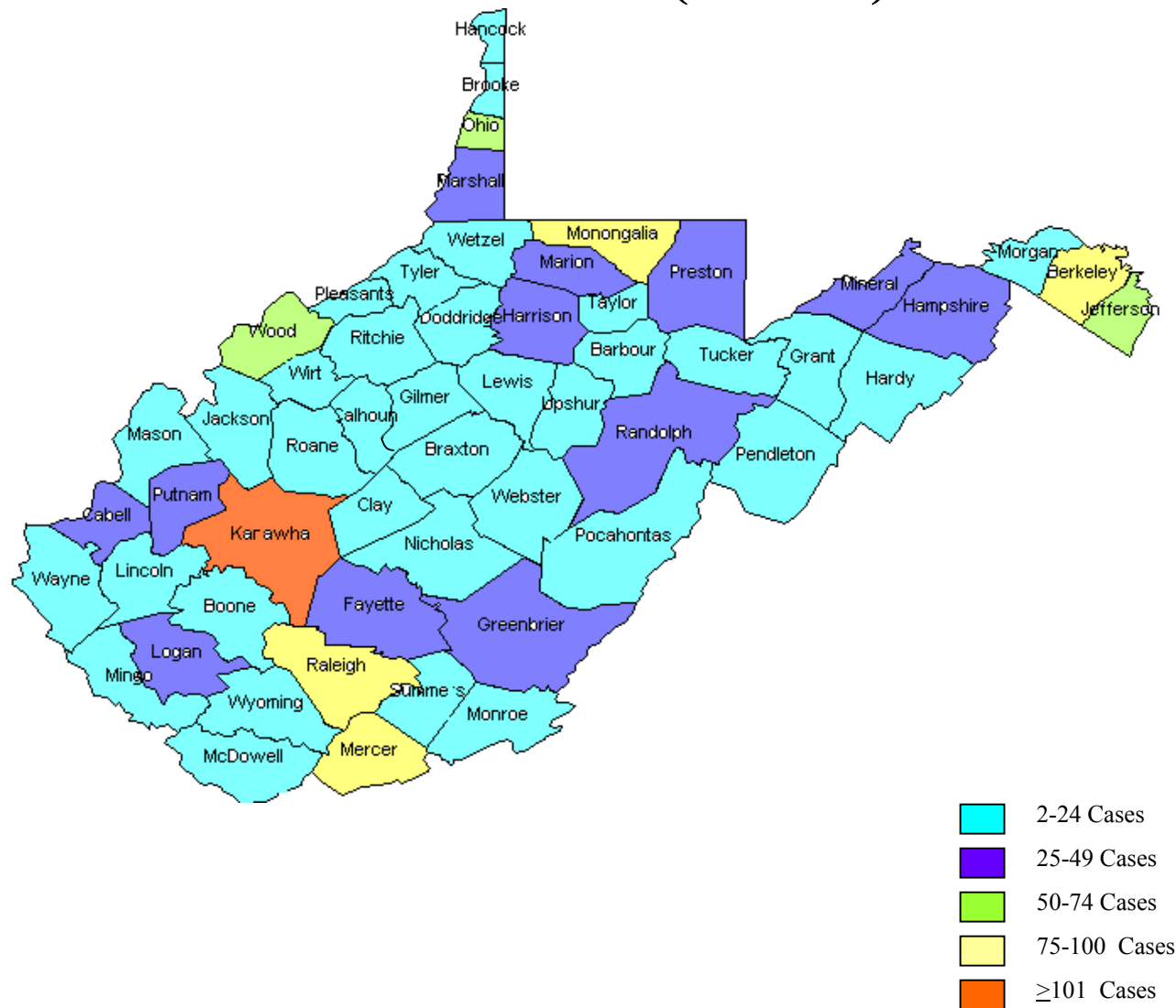


Cumulative Incidence Rate of Salmonella By Age Group In West Virginia 1995-2002
