Smallpox Vaccine Administration Check-Off List – Job Aid

Step-by-Step Procedure	Method
1. Vaccinator Preparation	 Review screening clearance form to assure vaccinee has screened him/herself and signed consent. Note whether vaccinee has received smallpox vaccination previously. <u>DO NOT</u> proceed if vaccinee has any contraindications!!! Prepare gauze and tape for bandage. Wear gloves.
2. Vaccine Preparation	 Prepare vaccine by: consulting package insert OR consulting protocol provided. Stabilize vaccine vial on flat surface and use provided vaccine holder.
3. Skin Preparation	 <u>NO</u> skin preparation is required, unless grossly visible dirt is present. If soap & water are used to clean visible dirt from skin, skin must be allowed to dry thoroughly. <u>DO NOT</u> use alcohol or acetone under any circumstances they inactivate the vaccinia virus.
4. Bifurcated Needle	 Remove bifurcated needle from its package. <u>DO NOT</u> touch the pointed end of the needle! Holding the bifurcated needle between your thumb and forefinger perpendicular to the floor, dip the point of the needle into the vaccine solution. Withdraw the needle from the solution; it will contain a drop of vaccine in the space between the two prongs. Caution: Needles should never be dipped into the vaccine vial after touching the skin, to avoid contamination of the vial.
5. Vaccination Method	 Refer to package insert or protocol for appropriate number of needle pricks to be administered. With your other hand, pull the skin taut on the deltoid region of the upper, non-dominant arm. Rest your wrist on the arm of the vaccinee. Position needle perpendicular to site of insertion. Make rapid insertions into an area less than 5mm in diameter; punctures should evoke a trace of blood after 15-30 seconds. If excess vaccine is noted on the site, dab site with a piece of gauze. Dispose of contaminated needle in biohazard sharps container. Also discard empty vaccine vial in sharps container.
6. Cover Vaccination Site	 Loosely cover vaccination site with a porous bandage, such as gauze. Apply tape over bandage. If vaccinee is reporting to work in the healthcare setting, gauze should be covered with a semi-permeable dressing.
7. Caution Vaccinee	 Caution and instruct vaccinee on how to take care of the site; handout fact sheet, Caring for the Smallpox Vaccination Site. <u>DO NOT</u> allow an unvaccinated person to come into contact with the site or contaminated materials from the site!!!
8. Vaccinator Preparation (prior to next patient)	 Remove gloves and discard. Disinfect hands. Don clean gloves.
