**TO:** State Parks in the Oral Rabies Vaccine (ORV) Distribution Area

**FROM:** The West Virginia Oral Rabies Vaccination Project

**RE:** **ORAL RABIES VACCINATION PROGRAM**

With a goal to stop the spread of the raccoon rabies variant in West Virginia, the West Virginia Department of Health and Human Resources, supported by other state and federal agencies, has implemented a program to immunize wild raccoons for rabies.

During August and September 2004, the West Virginia Department of Health and Human Resources and cooperators will be distributing rabies vaccine-laced baits to establish an immune barrier to halt the spread of raccoon strain rabies in West Virginia. We anticipate completion by the end of September. The target area covers a wide corridor through the central part of the state, extending from the northern panhandle to the southern coalfields. We will be using low-flying fixed wing aircraft to distribute the baits. Also included are several copies of two brochures which explain the Oral Rabies Vaccination project. Feel free to distribute these as you want, and copy them if needed.
