West Virginia counties receiving baits include: Barbour, Boone, Braxton, Brooke, Calhoun, Clay, Doddridge, Fayette, Gilmer, Greenbrier, Hancock, Harrison, Kanawha, Lewis, Logan, Marion, Marshall, McDowell, Mingo, Monongalia, Nicholas, Ohio, Pleasants, Preston, Raleigh, Randolph, Ritchie, Roane, Taylor, Tucker, Tyler, Upshur, Webster, Wetzel and Wyoming.

Also, counties that received baits for hand distribution last year will receive them again this year. With these baits, counties will receive instructions on the areas that need hand-baiting, and approximate number of baits to be distributed in each area. You will be receiving these baits mid-September. Counties that assist in hand-baiting should bill the State \$206.00 on their **September** rabies invoice. Do not put hand-baiting activities on the October invoice. October 1, 2004 is the beginning of a new grant period.
