

The Office of Laboratory Services has implemented a new security system; this implementation will bring with it several changes. The employee parking lot will be accessible by lab employees only. The visitor parking lot will be accessible Monday through Friday between the hours of 6:50 am and 5:00 pm. Due to this change, the after hours specimen drop off has been moved to a new building located at the east end of the property. To drop off a specimen, drive into the entrance of the employee parking lot. Press the intercom button for assistance; you will receive a response from a Security Guard located at the DHHR main office located at the Diamond Building in Charleston. Tell the guard what company you are with and you have a specimen to drop off. The guard will release the lock to the door so that you may enter the building. Inside the building you will find a refrigerator for specimens. Place your specimen into the refrigerator and exit the building. You will need to back out of the driveway to exit. The after hours specimen drop building will be under video surveillance at all times.
