- What days and hours are you open?
- Do I need to make an appointment or do you take walk-ins? (Can I make one now?)
- Can you send me any necessary papers that I will need to fill-out and mail in?
- What personal papers and items do I need to bring with me (such as; Drivers License, Birth Certificate(s), Social Security Card(s), paycheck stubs, utility bill(s), etc.)?
- Can you tell me your address, and give directions how to get there please?
