PREGNANCY OPTIONS COUNSELING

Title X Family Planning providers are required to offer Pregnancy Options Counseling to all women and teens who receive a positive pregnancy test result. This includes a discussion of the options that are available to the client: prenatal care and delivery, parenting, foster care or adoption, and abortion.

Through lecture, discussion, self-assessment, team activities, and case scenarios, participants in this training will explore their feelings and responses to options counseling and how they impact the work they do. Participants will also learn client-centered skills that can be applied to help a client explore her feelings and concerns about her pregnancy, weigh the available alternatives, and make an independent decision.

After completing this training event, participants will be able to:

- Describe the “options” a woman has when she becomes pregnant
- Implement the 3 Key Elements to an Options Counseling session

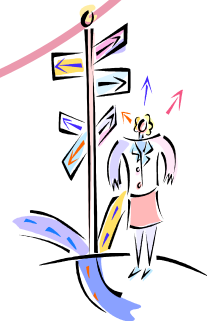
