In the filing of rules promulgated by all state agencies, the Secretary of State's office has designed a system that is quite similar to that used by the federal government (CFR's). The Code of State Regulations (CSR) will be preceded by a two digit number. All of the Department of Health's Rules are assigned title 64. Therefore, the Department of Health Rules will appear as 64 CSR (series). The CSR will be followed by a series number specific to the referenced rule. For example:

General Sanitation Rule is numbered 64 CSR 18
 Food Establishments Rule is numbered 64 CSR 17
 Recreational Water Facilities Rule is numbered 64 CSR 16

When preparing notices and enforcement letters, cite the applicable section of the rule by using the section number and the subject title of the rule being enforced. For example, if action is being taken for batch feeding of chlorine at a swimming pool, the owner/operator would be in violation of "section 7.1.b. of 64 CSR 16, Recreational Water Facilities Rule."
