The following identification numbers shall be used to identify West Virginia listed pasteurization plants, single service manufacturers, frozen dessert plants, tanker truck wash stations and bulk tank units (BTU's) under the national uniform coding system:

Additionally, the state milk rating officer must include the BTU or plant identification number on the 2359i form (Interstate Milk Shipper Report) or 2359d form (Report of Certification – Fabrication of Single Service Containers and Closures for Milk and Milk Products) when conducting state ratings.
