INSTRUCTIONS

Applicant must be registered with the West Virginia State Tax Department, have a valid general contractor license issued by the West Virginia Division of Labor, and have at least one West Virginia licensed clandestine drug laboratory remediation technician to obtain a CDLR Contractor License. **Attach all required documentation. Incomplete application will not be processed.**

1. Complete sections A and B.
2. Attach required documentation:
 - a. Copy of West Virginia State Tax Department registration certificate.
 - b. Copy of West Virginia Division of Labor General Contractor license.
 - c. Proof of a minimum of one currently licensed West Virginia clandestine drug laboratory remediation technician. Contractor and technician licenses may be applied for simultaneously.
 - d. A list of state(s) in which technicians hold valid license(s) and the license number(s).
 - e. A list of state(s) applicant holds CDLR contractor license(s) and the license number(s).
 - f. History of any previous environmental enforcement action(s) taken against the applicant and the outcome.
3. Attach check or money order made payable to the West Virginia Bureau for Public Health in the amount of the required \$300 licensing fee. Tax is not applicable. Please do not send cash.
