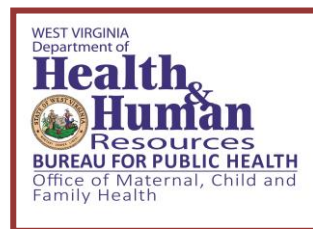


# West Virginia Pregnancy Risk Assessment Monitoring System (PRAMS) –Analytic Report, December 2016



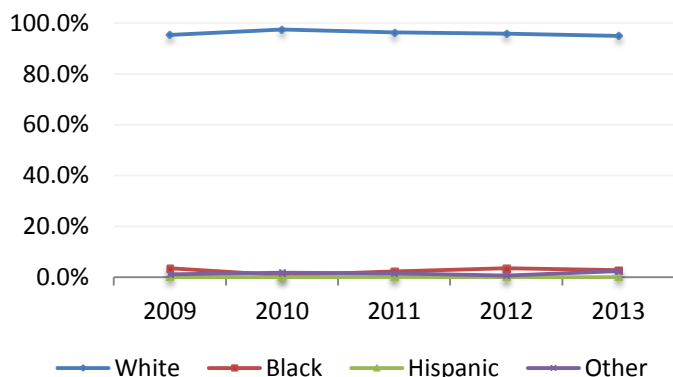
## Prevalence of mothers who had their teeth cleaned during their most recent pregnancy in West Virginia

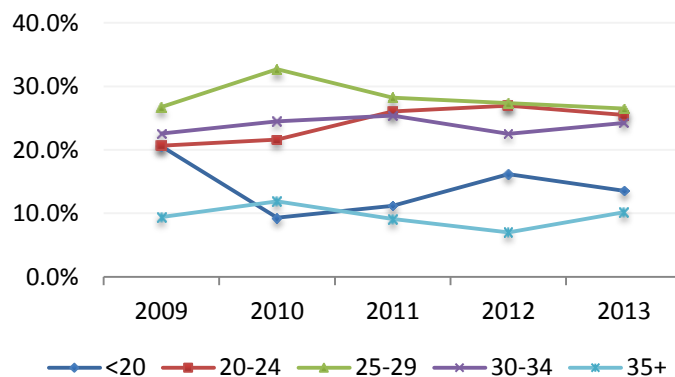
### Quick Facts:

- Caring for your teeth and gums is very important for both the mother's and the baby's health.
- The rates for women who had their teeth cleaned during pregnancy have increased from 31.9% in 2009 to 41.9% in 2013.
- Women between the ages of 24-29, are a college graduate, and an income of \$50,000 or greater are more likely to have their teeth cleaned during pregnancy.

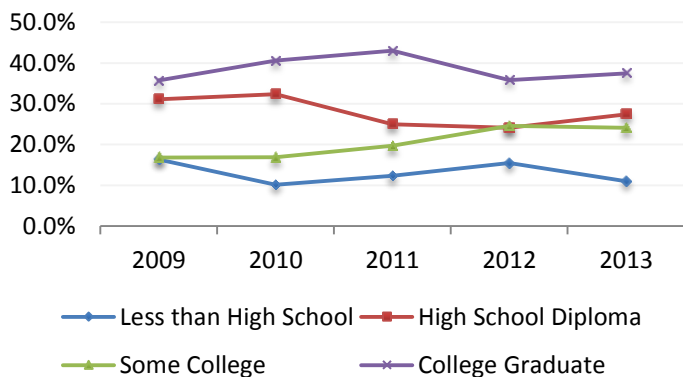
**Mothers Who Had Their Teeth Cleaned During Pregnancy by Race, PRAMS 2009-2013**
