An evaluation report including recommendations for an additional service such as corrective lenses must be submitted to WVBTT to obtain prior authorization. <u>This authorization</u> <u>does not pertain to ongoing treatment of any diagnosed medical condition.</u>

The purpose of the letter is to authorize a vision evaluation for the above child, as a component of the overall assessment and service provision process under Part C of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA). The purpose of the evaluation is to provide information to the child's Individualized Family Service Plan (IFSP) team members for intervention planning purposes.
