WV Birth to Three Family Assessment is in final draft. 	 Five Interim Service Coordinators will pilot the Family Assessment Form to assist in final edits for statewide scale up. The pilot will evaluate the time required to complete the form, the content areas, ease for facilitating the conversational interview, and value in assisting in the selection of the evaluation/assessment team and planning for the IFSP. Family Assessment will be implemented by Interim Service Coordinators, October 1, 2017.
