

SOCIAL EMOTIONAL ASSESSMENT/ EVALUATION MEASURE (SEAM)

The SEAM is an assessment that focuses exclusively on social-emotional and behavioral development in young children and provides meaningful insights to caregivers and families. It provides in-depth information that can prevent problems by building positive partnerships with families and optimizing positive parent-child interactions in the first years of life.

The goal is to provide training and support to assist you in integrating the SEAM into the evaluation/assessment process and to develop outcomes and intervention activities to support families and children.

Space is limited to 25 direct service practitioners who have an average of 10 families on their caseload.
