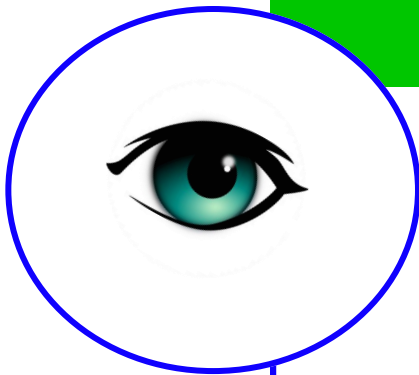

## Introducing the “Why Early Relationships Matter” Brochure to Families

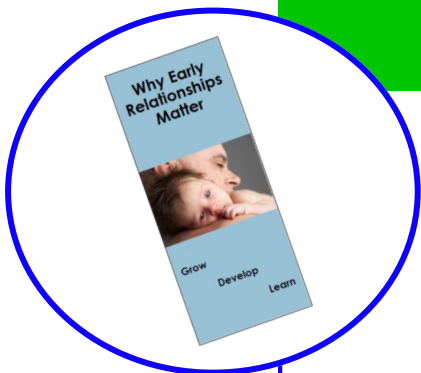
### Notice



Observe and communicate to the family what they are doing to support their child's social emotional development, for example:

- I like the way you praised him for picking up his toys.
- I see how much he enjoys reading books with you.
- Singing is such a great way to encourage her to listen.

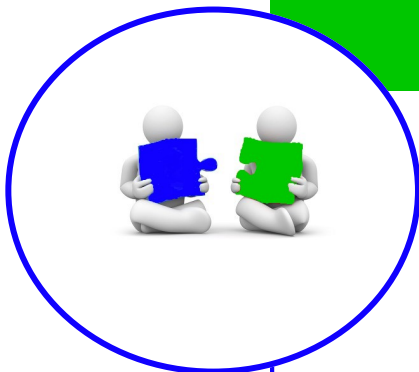
### Share



Introduce the brochure to families by communicating these key concepts to explore if they would like to learn more:

- You are your child's first and best teacher.
- You play an important role in your child's social emotional development.
- Social emotional development happens in everything we do.
