

Smoking remains the leading cause of preventable death and has negative impacts on people at all stages of life. 2

Each year, more than 440,000 Americans die from cigarette smoking.*

Giving up smoking rapidly reduces the risk of developing serious health problems. After a number of years, the risk of heart disease, for example, diminishes to the same level as a person who has never smoked.⁹

Cigarettes kill more Americans than alcohol, car accidents, suicide, AIDS, homicide, and illegal drugs combined ¹⁰

If you or someone you love smokes, here's what you need to know about how smoking kills, and how to get the help needed to guit...once and for all:

- Smoking is a major cause of heart disease, aneurysms, and stroke- and contributes to the severity of pneumonia and asthma
- More than 4,000 individual compounds have been identified in tobacco smoke. Among these are more than 60 compounds that are known carcinogens (cancer-causing agents)
- The list of diseases caused by smoking has been expanded to include abdominal aortic aneurysm, acute myeloid leukemia, cataract, cervical cancer, kidney cancer, pancreatic cancer, pneumonia, periodontitis, and stomach cancer¹³

- West Virginia has the nation's fourth highest rate of smoking-related deaths in the United States¹⁴
- One in five deaths in West Virginia is related to smoking "
- West Virginia's youth smoking rate is one of the highest in the nation. 28.5 percent of the state's high school youth smoke compared to about 26 percent of adults 16
- West Virginians pay \$1.8 billion a year for the direct health care and occupational costs of smoking¹⁷
- More than 4,000 West Virginians die each year --12 every day -- from smoking-related diseases¹
