

The Children with Special Health Care Needs Program, located within the West Virginia Department of Health and Human Resources (DHHR), Office of Maternal, Child and Family Health, is seeking to hire a registered nurse for Elkins, WV and surrounding areas. The civil service classification for this position is a Nurse III and the salary is \$36,340.00/year. The position will be housed in the Randolph County DHHR office in Elkins, WV. The nurse will provide medical care coordination for children from birth through age 20, who have chronic or disabling medical conditions. Some services are provided in clinic settings, as well as through home and other face-to-face visits. The nurse will work on a team consisting of a nurse and a social service worker. The nurse is responsible for working with physicians, orthotists, audiologists, and other specialized community service providers to provide comprehensive care to clients. The nurse will provide care coordination, indirect patient care, client/family education, and transition services to clients within a specific geographical area. The nurse should be familiar with community resources. Previous care coordination experience is a plus. Statewide travel is possible. Hours are Monday through Friday, 8:30A – 4:30P (no weekends, holidays or on-call). Applicants must apply for employment with the West Virginia Division of Personnel and be on the Nurse III register for Randolph County.
