Department programs by providing
due process to appellants through
impartial hearings and timely
decisions***

The Board of Review is authorized under state law and functions to provide a fair, impartial, and expeditious hearing process to DHHR customers and providers who feel themselves aggrieved by Agency action. By affording the right to a hearing, the Board ensures due process of law to individuals who are impacted by DHHR programs including, but not limited to:

- *Adult Protective Services*
- *Aged/Disabled Waiver*
- *Child Protective Services*
- *Certified Nursing Assistant Abuse/Neglect Registry*
- *Child Care Eligibility*
- *Child Care Providers*
- *Foster Care Providers*
- *I/DD Waiver*
- *LIEAP*
- *Medicaid Eligibility*
- *Medical Services*
- *School Clothing Allowance*
- *SNAP Eligibility*
- *SNAP Disqualification Hearings*
- *Women, Infants and Children*
- *WV CHIP*
- *WV WORKS*

Hearings with the Board of Review

Hearings are presided over by State Hearing Officers or an Administrative Law Judge and are held in person at local DHHR offices, by telephone conference or by video conference.

Reasons for hearings include, but are not limited to:

- *Denial of benefits*
- *Termination of benefits*
- *Reduction of benefits*
- *Disputes over findings by CPS and APS*
- *Closure or denial of foster homes*
- *Closure or denial of child care providers*
- *Determination of SNAP Intentional Program Violations*
- *Nursing Home transfer/discharge*
- *Disqualifications of WIC vendors*
